A qualified trainer for sports, Hannelore wears the Aqualine orthosis in the pool and teaches children, teenagers and adults how to swim. With the Aqualine orthosis, she can help course participants make corrections from the side of the pool. Showering has become a simple routine as well thanks to the waterproof orthosis, while it used to be a difficult and complicated process involving two forearm crutches. The trainer would like to see as many people with restricted mobility wearing the Aqualine orthosis as possible – so they too can experience independence and a higher quality of life.



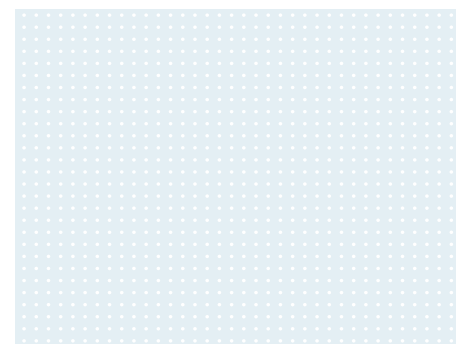
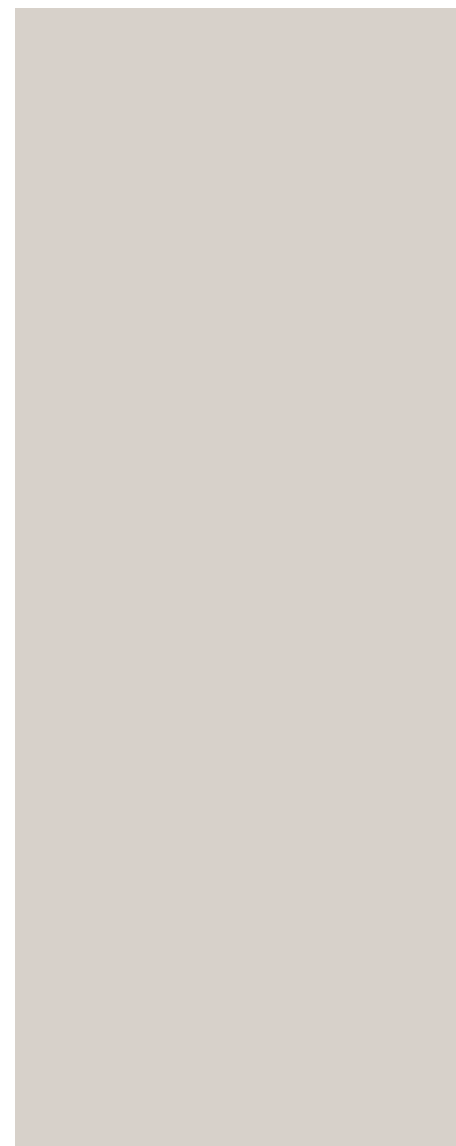
“Before I got the Aqualine orthosis, it was really difficult. Now I feel really sure of myself when I’m walking and I’m not afraid of falling anymore.”

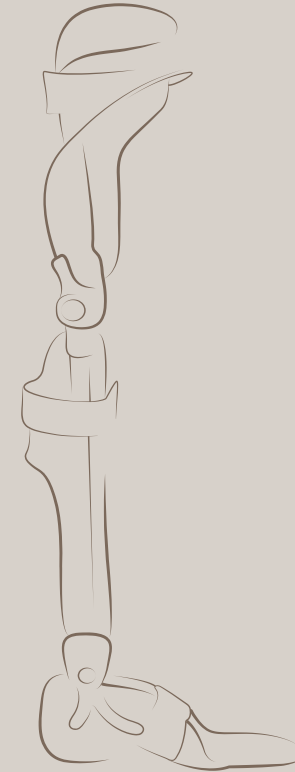




Aqualine orthosis

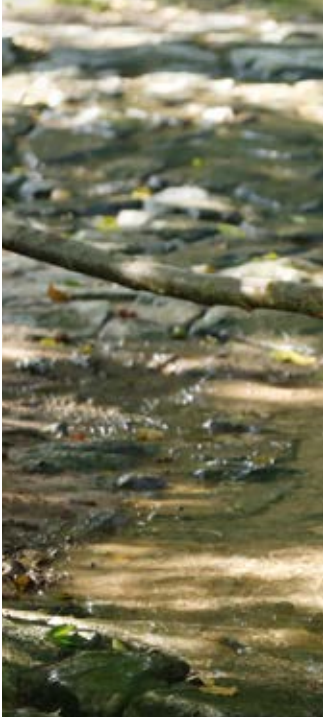
